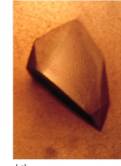
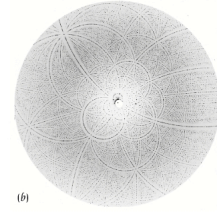

Project description:
