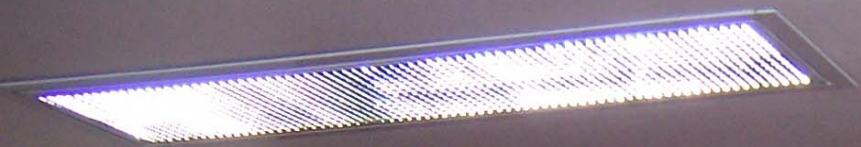














**Whereas,**
